Sheldon and Joan Treibitz, residents of Lake County, FL for 20 years travel back to Brooklyn, New York to visit the Treibitz family cemetery plot for potentially the last time. Joan and Sheldon take viewers and their granddaughter, Shelley, the director of the film, along a familiar route to their homecoming, a drive they've driven for over twenty years. While traveling to New York City, they stop to visit family, who once lived in close quarters with them in Brooklyn when they were a young couple. Throughout their travels they revisit their past lives in Brooklyn and visit their family's first documented history in the United States, Ellis Island, rewriting and sharing their past with the future generation of their family.

Synopsis: *Gatekeeper* is a story about the relationship between a natural environment and the rural communities of Miami-Dade County. Miami-Dade County, a historically rich county, where generations of families have fished and farmed, cared for the land, and created a blooming multicultural city full of food, music, art, and integration with the surrounding habitats. Known as the "Homesteaders Trail", a major hub to the Florida railroad, residents of Miami-Dade are cultivators of environmental protection and education for the surrounding area, and act as a gatekeeper to enter Biscayne National Park as well as a gateway for migration from the Caribbean islands and Mexico to the United States.

# MRTS 4412.002 Film Production Topics – Contemporary Documentary Filmmaking:

Introduces students to various methodologies used to study documentary texts and media, bridging the gap between meaning, and making. Focusing on the student's relationship(s) to the real world and telling stories, how to establish a set of documentary ethics and a filmmaker's voice and making contemporary documentary cinema. Students will explore contemporary and experimental developments of documentary approaches, terminology, filmmakers, and concepts of thought.

MRTS 2210.002 Introduction to MRTS Production – Audio: An introduction to basic techniques. Audio, television (studio and location) and single-camera video and film methods are investigated. Includes production exercises and experiments.
